

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The counties of Sacramento and Yolo participated in a region-wide exercise of the Tri-County Alerting Systems. Placer County did not participate in this year's exercise. These systems are the local public notification system for, and financially supported by, all three counties. At 10:19 a.m. on Thursday, October 19th, 2023 the counties conducted an exercise of the alert systems, contacting residents whom opted-in, as well as reverse 9-1-1.










Operator Intercept are calls which received a network generated error such as "phone disconnected" or "all circuits busy" etc.

#### **Tri-County Messaging**

On October 19th, 2023 the Sacramento and Yolo Operational Areas launched the Tri-County Alerting Systems to Opt-In and 9-1-1 residential and business databases. Sacramento County sent the alert in nine total languages (including English).

#### Phone, Email, Rave Guardian, Rave Smart911:

This exercise tests our ability to deliver emergency notifications to residents during a disaster. During an actual emergency, important information will be sent to you through this system. #### **Strengths**

The following strengths were identified:

- Sent exercise verbiage in nine different languages
- Used new system to send county-wide alerts by all means (except IPAWS)
- The send process began immediately

#### Area for Improvement 1: Rave Email "From Address"

Currently, the "From Address" in Rave for email alerts is "sacoes@getrave.com" and some residents have mentioned that it looks like spam.

#### **Recommendation:**

We are currently working with County Department of Technology and Rave to update the "From Address" to "sacalert@saccounty.gov."

#### **Area for Improvement 2: Post Exercise Survey**

As of November 16<sup>th</sup>, 4,724 people responded to the survey our of the hundreds of thousands of contacts the alert went to. Part of the reason for lower-than-expected respondents was because the survey was sent as a separate alert after the exercise, and not as part of the exercise message.

#### **Recommendation:**

Include survey link and description in the body of the exercise message.

#### **Area for Improvement 3: Public Awareness of Exercise**

Many survey responses indicated an unawareness of the upcoming exercise. Not having awareness of the exercise, and then receiving alerts, tends to confuse, and frustrate residents. A larger, earlier effort to inform residents is essential.

#### Recommendation:

Work closely with Public Information Officers to periodically advertise the SacAlert system, how to sign up, and benefits of signing up. Advertise exercise early and often via all media and social media avenues.

## **OUTREACH ANALYSIS**

OES posted on Facebook and Twitter the Monday prior and the morning of the exercise. Due to a **real** earthquake that morning, our reminder post included information about that earthquake informing our community that this was different than the exercise. That post's engagement was much higher in engagement.

Performance of this activity did not contribute to additional health and/or safety risks for the public or for emergency workers, and it was conducted in accordance with applicable plans, policies, procedures, regulations, and laws; however, opportunities to enhance effectiveness and/or efficiency were identified.
- Performed with Major Challenges (M): The targets and critical tasks associated with the core capability were completed in a manner that achieved the objective(s), but some or all of the following were observed: demonstrated performance had a negative impact on the performance of other activities; contributed to additional health and/or safety risks for the public or for emergency workers; and/or was not conducted in accordance with applicable plans, policies, procedures, regulations, and laws.
- Unable to be Performed (U) The targets and critical tasks associated with the core capability were not performed in a manner that achieved the objective(s).



## Did you receive the SacAlert on Thursday October 19th, 2023?



## Did you know about the alert prior to October 19th?



## If so, how did you learn about the October 19th alert exercise?




## How did you receive the alert? (check all that apply)


In which language did you receive the alert?


